RELIGION: We read the Bible stories: Jesus Dies and is Buried & Jesus Rises from the Dead. We began a new unit. In this unit, we will learn about Jesus' resurrection and how He is with us each day. We need to share this Good News with others. The May memory is attached to this newsletter.

READING: Our stories this week were: The Dot, Artists Create Art, Bears, and Hiding and Seeking. Our high-frequency words were: above, bear, even, pushed, studied, surprised, teacher, toward. We learned that when we add the endings -ed and -ing, we need to drop a letter or double the consonant sometimes. We learned that the letter "y" at the end of a word sometimes makes the long "e" sound. We reviewed figurative language and found some evidence of this in our story this week.

MATH: We looked at and reviewed the different strategies that we can use to subtract multiples of 10. We took a test on Chapter 11.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We learned that maps are most often used to show specific things about our world and can be very detailed. Globes show us a bigger and broader look at the world.

SCIENCE: It was Earth Day on Monday. We read about this special day and came up with ideas on how we can take care of this beautiful earth that God gave us.

ART: We drew a picture of a stingray. We learned how to create shadow by making the different parts of the stingray darker.
