Literacy

This was our first week in our anthologies! We practiced using the Table of Contents. We learned our new vocabulary words. From reading our the story, **Henry and Mudge**, we practiced retelling a story by talking about the beginning, middle, and end. We reviewed endmarks and how our voice should change depending on what is used at the end of the sentence. Your second grader also had the opportunity to practice subject and predicate independently in our stations. Stations occur for twenty minutes which allow me to have guided reading with a small group. Mrs. Knoell provides support during this time. Our brain builder for Friday was famished.

Math

This week we focused on finding patterns. This week we began taking our first timed math facts test. The test on addition 2 facts will go home early next week.
