RELIGION: The Holy Spirit gives believers the power to lead a life which witnesses boldly to God's love and grace. We read the Bible stories: The Ascension and Pentecost. We recognize that the Holy Spirit plants and grows faith in the hearts of God's people. With the Holy Spirit's power, we can boldly speak about God's love in Jesus to others.

READING: Our stories this week were: Days with Toad and Frog: The Kite & Measuring Weather, Sally Jane and Beth Ann, Ty and Big Gilly, and Bird Watching. Our high-frequency words were: across, ball, cried, head, heard, large, second, should. We concentrated on the long vowel "i" sound using the -igh, y, -ie spelling pattern. We learned that an adjective is a word used to describe a noun. When there are three adjectives in a sentence, a comma is used after the first two adjectives and is followed by the word and.

MATH: We learned to tell time to the hour and half hour. We learned how to read an analog and digital clock. We also looked at how we can organize data and show it in a tally chart.

SCIENCE: We learned that animals are put into different groups or classifications. We discussed the attributes of each group of animals and had to put an animal in the correct classification.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We further investigated how to read a map using the map key.
