#### **Literacy**

Our story this week was about dogs. We talked about what makes them such a good pet and what they need to stay healthy. Multiple meaning words were practiced and hard and soft c sounds were introduced. We are still building a strong reading base by reviewing our long vowels. Coming home you will find punctuation pockets which helped us review our endmarks.

### <u>Math</u>

This week we focused on patterns and skip counting by 5's, 10's,100's, and counting forward and backward. We reviewed for our first math test and took it on Friday. It will be coming home next week. It looks exactly like our regular math sheets except on the top it says Chapter 1 Review/Test. TEST is circled. As you know, we began our time tests this week. There will be two stapled together. The one on top is the test we took on Monday and then the bottom test is the final one which was taken on Friday. From studying throughout the week, the main goal is for your second grader to improve from Monday to Friday. Coming home this week are the time tests for 1's. Don't panic, they were not sent home to study. It was simply a practice from last week so your second grader would know what to expect when we started the 2's. One minute and thirty seconds is given to complete 30 problems. Remember the goal is to slowly get away from using fingers and to have the facts memorized.
