WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- \checkmark The presentation should be 3-5 minutes long.
- ✓ The objects you use for your presentation should be <u>connected to the mystery</u> <u>or the clues to solve the mystery</u>. The objects should **not** be for the characters of your story.
- ✓ The objects can be homemade. However, they cannot be just pictures of the items.
- ✓ If you use the book talk plan and need more space to write about the clues, please use a piece of notebook paper.
- ✓ Students will be graded on their presentation. I will not be grading their book talk plan or their note cards. On the class website is the rubric I will use to grade this book report.
- ✓ Remember to practice your presentation at home so you know your story well.
