PTL Volunteer Descriptions

Elegant Farmer: Help sort the orders and assist the day of pick-up.

Family pizza/game night: Chairperson-This position will organize our family pizza/game night.. **Committee**-Assist chairperson with planning and/or volunteer during game night.

Field Day: Chairperson-Oversee and organize games, and volunteers for a fun end of year day. Committee-Be a part of the planning committee, set-up, clean-up, or run games.

Glow Event: Family event for all ages where everything is glow-in-the-dark.

Ice cream "truck": Chair: Purchase ice cream , send out flyers, and organize volunteers to work during the lunch hour. **Committee**- Sell ice cream during the lunch hour. This event will take place once per guarter.

Pizza Sale: Help sort the orders and assist the day of pick-up.

Scholastic Book Fair: This event is help twice a year. Volunteers will be needed to help with the set-up and break down of the fair and working the fair when it is open before and after school. There is also a need for volunteers to work the fair during the scheduled family events.

Silent Auction: Volunteers are needed for this event from the planning stages all the way to the day of the event. There are several different opportunities to serve with the auction such as securing raffle items, class baskets, set-up and clean-up.
